Subject: - Development/Revision of Syllabi for Central Superior Services (CSS) Competitive Examination

Dear Mv. Fasih-ud-Din Sb!

As you are aware, the Federal Public Service Commission (FPSC), among other responsibilities, is entrusted with the task of selection of suitable candidates for the Central Superior Services (CSS) in BPS-17 who are subsequently assigned to twelve Occupational Groups of the Federal Civil Services. For doing so, it conducts an annual examination comprising four components i.e. a Written Examination, Psychological Assessment, a Medical Examination and Viva Voce. The written examination comprises 1200 marks covering 600 marks for the Compulsory Subjects and 600 marks for the Optional Subjects.

2. The FPSC is in the process of revising the scheme and syllabi of the written examinations which includes a review of the **weightage** of each of the existing subjects, the **syllabus** of each subject and **suggested readings** prescribed for subjects included in the examination. It is also intended to introduce some new Optional Subjects. **These changes are intended to be introduced w.e.f. CSS Examination due to be held in February/ March 2013.**

3. You have been considered by FPSC as an Expert for developing the syllabus for "**Criminology**" which itself is indeed a great honour. It will be a matter of immense contribution for the Country's premier government cadre if you can help the FPSC in formulating a syllabus for the subject as it is being introduced for the first time. However, a draft syllabus on criminology alongwith list of suggested books is enclosed for consideration and further improvement. (Annex-A)

4. **Parameters/ Guidelines.** Some important parameters that may be adopted and guidelines to be followed and which you may find useful for the purpose are as follows:

- a. Weightage of the subject of "**Criminology**" will be of 100 marks,
- b. All subjects carrying weightage of 200 marks are tested through two papers and those with 100 marks through one paper. This arrangement will continue.

- c. The level of the syllabus should be that of Bachelor's Honours,
- d. Suggested readings for the subject may be provided alongwith the draft syllabus. However, it is **important** that the suggested readings are easily available in the local market so that candidates can have access to these books for preparation.

5. As indicated earlier, the revised syllabus is intended to be introduced from CSS 2013. Before that, it has to pass through a number of stages of vetting, approval and advertisement for information of the prospective candidates of the Examination. It is, therefore requested that the highest priority may please be rendered to the matter and the revised syllabus be communicated alongwith the recommended readings within ONE MONTH of the issue of this letter.




